7	Any Other Business Temporary Members Monica had had a few enquiries regarding non members bringing boats to the club. It would be nice if we could facilitate this, so asked for suggestions on how to do this. It was agreed we would need to put together an application form, which would come from the member who would sponsor the non-member and be present whilst they are using the facilities, both would sign the form. Monica was happy to administer this. It was agreed $\pounds 25$ would be the price as members have to pay $\pounds 15.30$ to launch a boat not kept in the boat park, so we would add a temporary member fee of $\pounds 10$ . It would have the usual limit of 6 times before they would have to become members and there would be absolutely no storage. It was agreed non-members, without a member to sponsor and be present, would not be able to use the club as it would be too hard to administer.
