

NOTICE TO COMPETITORS

CCSC – Change to the Sailing Programme 2020

1: Races and events on or prior to Sunday 5th July 2020 are cancelled.

Explanation

The Club Sailing Programme is published in the Club Handbook annually in March. Government restrictions due to the spread of the virus Covid-19 have preventing this sailing programme from running.

2: Replace the Sailing Programme from Monday 6th July 2020 to Sunday 16th August as follows:

Provided conditions are suitable safety cover sessions will be provided on water at the following times.

Club members are welcome to sail but must not congregate in gatherings of more than 6 people, onshore or afloat, and social distancing of 2m (1m+ if mitigations are in place) must be observed at all times.

3. Notes

Note 1. Informal racing may take place during these sessions with each boat individually recording their start, end, elapsed times and number of laps. Results may be aggregated on Hals to form one or more series.

Note 2. A course may be set by the OD and displayed ashore or from the Committee Boat.

Note 3. Boats should stay in the proximity of the course unless free sailing and not requiring safety cover.

Note 4. Safety boats will usually have 1 crew and the organising team will be minimal to meet Covid-19 requirements. With the reduced safety provision available OD's will not run safety cover unless they are satisfied conditions permit safe sailing. Individually, boats intending to sail MUST be satisfied they are within their capabilities in the conditions prevailing and expected.

Note 5. Sessions may terminate early if conditions deteriorate or safety resources are overwhelmed. Boats not free sailing must return to shore.

Note 6. Sailors are requested to use any and all of the 4 water access points for launching and recovery and to stagger their departure and return to assist in maintaining social distance.
